These non-circulating collections, comprising more than 800 volumes, are inter-shelved on the second floor of the Westmoreland County Museum located in Courthouse Square in Montross, Virginia. The Library and Museum are conveniently close to the old County Courthouse of Westmoreland where deeds, wills, and court orders are stored.

### THE COLLECTIONS

The Northern Neck of Virginia Historical Society collects and makes available to historical researchers both print and non-print materials on the history of the Northern Neck. A geographic area of significance since the early days of European settlement in the New World, the counties of the Northern Neck and year of formation are Northumberland-1648, Lancaster-1651, Westmoreland-1653, Stafford-1664, Richmond-1692 & King George-1721.

The Westmoreland County Museum Library and the Henry Hungerford Library include materials on the history of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Also of interest are the collected works and biographies of various U. S. Presidents, Westmoreland County records, order books, deeds, patents, & wills, and microfilm of *The Northern Neck News*.

Other materials of importance to researchers include microfilm of Virginia census records; more than 80 bound volumes of family history; numerous files of unbound family history materials; vital records; parish and cemetery records; and military studies including most volumes of the Virginia Regimental Histories series.
