

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP

The Westmoreland County Courthouse Square Revitalization Committee will hold a public workshop on April 27, 2011, in the auditorium of the A.T. Johnson Alumni Museum located at 18849 Kings Highway in Montross, VA from 5:00 to 7:00 PM.

The Courthouse Square Revitalization Committee was appointed by the County Board of Supervisors to develop options for the use of the old county courthouse building at the corner of State Route 3 and Polk Street, the current Sheriff's office, and other county owned buildings around the courthouse square – should they become vacant.

The committee would like to know the ideas and opinions of the public. The public is invited to come to the workshop to find out more about the buildings and about some of the options for the future that have so far been identified. This workshop is not a forum for public opinion on the merits of building a new courthouse, which is outside the scope of the Revitalization Committee. Light refreshments will be served.

Information about the buildings will be available for public review during regular business hours in the office of the Land Use Administrator, in the George D. English, Sr. Memorial Building, 111 Polk Street, Montross, VA. Comments and suggestions for the committee can also be delivered to this office.
