Minutes, November 7 and 8, 2018

Members in attendance: Barry Millward, Cordelia Ray and Sharon Vassiliades
Others attending: Kristin Hicks, Director of Elections/General Registrar

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. on November 7, and determined that a quorum was present.

The provisional ballot meeting was called to order at 9:08 a.m. The Chairman closed the meeting stating: "I move the Electoral Board of Westmoreland County convene in closed session pursuant to section 24.2-653(B) of the Code of Virginia to consider whether the persons who submitted provisional votes at the election were qualified to do so, and I also move that the general registrar be allowed to remain in the room during the closed meeting. The motions were seconded by the secretary and carried unanimously. There were no voters or authorized representative at the meeting.

The closed meeting concluded at 10:00 a.m. with the Chairman stating "the closed session provisional ballot meeting will now reconvene as an open meeting. The Chairman also moved the Electoral Board of Westmoreland County certify that in the closed session just concluded the only matters discussed were the qualifications of 25 provisional voters as directed by 24.2-653 of the Code of Virginia and as identified in the motion to close the meeting pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. The motion was seconded by the Secretary and was carried.

The Electoral Board received 25 provisional ballots and after careful review 12 were qualified.

THE CANVASS

Precinct 101 – Carmel Church: Had 4 provisional ballots. Paperwork was complete and accurate.

Precinct 102 – A. T. Johnson: Had 1 provisional ballot. Some paperwork had to be completed.

Precinct 201 – Cople Elementary School: Had 1 provisional ballot. Paperwork was complete and accurate.

Precinct 202 – Stratford Harbour Club House: Had 4 provisional ballots. Some paperwork not complete.

Precinct 301 - Washington and Lee High School: Had 2 provisional ballots. Some paperwork had to be completed.

Precinct 302 – Oak Grove Community Life Center. Had no provisional ballots. Paperwork complete and accurate.

Precinct 401 – Oak Grove Fire House: Had 4 provisional ballots. Paperwork complete and accurate.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting at 3:45 p.m. stating “I move that the meeting of the Electoral Board of Westmoreland County stand adjourned until November 8, 2018, at 9 a.m. in the Voter Registration Office.” The Board concurred.

The Chairman reconvened the meeting on November 8, 2018 at 9:30 a.m. in the Voter Registration Office.

Precinct 501 – Colonial Beach: Had 9 provisional ballots. Paperwork complete and accurate.

Central Absentee Precinct (CAP): Had no provisional ballots. Some paperwork had to be completed.

Copies the Abstract of Votes and one Write-in Certification are attached.

The Chairman motioned to adjourn the meeting, the Secretary seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 3:45 p.m.
