* In order to dispose of a structure by burning:

If considering the burning of a structure, contact the local fire station in advance of your desired start date to discuss the project and schedule a site visit if they wish to conduct a preliminary inspection (contact list is on the third page).

Prior to starting the fire, call the non-emergency phone number for the Westmoreland County Sheriff's office 804-493-8066 and notify dispatch in case there are calls from concerned citizens. Also, ensure that Westmoreland County/Virginia is not under a "burn ban" as described below. Under no circumstances are structures made of any asbestos material permitted to be burned. Statewide Burn Ban: There is a statewide burn ban in effect every year from February 15 to April 1. During this period, burning is only permitted between the hours of 4 pm and midnight when winds have typically died down. Please note that, in times of extremely dry weather, the County or state may impose an additional (unscheduled) burn ban.

Furthermore, I hereby agree to grade and stabilize (e.g. seed and straw) the property immediately after the demolition is complete. I also agree to install erosion control measures (e.g. silt fence) as needed on down-slopes until stabilization is achieved. I understand that this permit for demolition does not permit me to conduct any additional land clearing beyond the building footprint (or I will request and receive a Land Disturbing Permit to conduct land disturbing outside of the building footprint).
