NOTICE: ADDRESSING DUPLICATE ROAD NAMES IN WESTMORELAND COUNTY

Westmoreland County officials have identified some instances of duplicate road names within the County. This situation can present public safety concerns, as emergency responders may experience delays or confusion when responding to calls from locations with identical street names.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROCESS:

Before implementing any changes to road names, Westmoreland County is committed to a transparent process that includes:

- 1. **Community Notification:** All residents living on affected roads will receive direct notifications about potential changes.
- 2. **Community Meetings:** A public information session will be held to explain the situation, discuss options, and gather input from residents. These community meetings will be posted on the County's Facebook page.
- 3. **Public Hearings:** A formal public hearing at a Board of Supervisors' meeting will allow residents to provide official comments on proposed name changes.
- 4. **Final Decision Process:** The County will carefully consider all feedback before finalizing any road name changes.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR AFFECTED RESIDENTS:

If you live on a road that may be renamed, you will receive detailed information about:

- Why changes are necessary
- The timeline for potential changes
- How to participate in the decision-making process

Westmoreland County is committed to working with our residents to ensure all road names are compliant with public safety requirements while minimizing disruption to residents.
